At 7:30 PM a Public Hearing was called to order to consider proposed Local Law # 2-2017, Tax Cap Override. The Town Clerk presents proof of publication. There being no comments for or against the meeting was closed at 7:31 PM.

LOCAL LAW # 2-2017 TAX CAP OVERRRIDE - Supervisor Pemrick states the Town of Greenfield is considering going over the Tax Cap. The purpose of this Local Law is to override the tax levy limit. The increase would be less than 2%. This would help to upgrade and expand our recreation program, support the long standing road improvement program and to keep on top of the obvious growth that is taking place in the Town of Greenfield. The Tax Cap limits the Town to plan and prepare for the future of the Town of Greenfield. Johnson, C. states that it would allow us to continue our program of Clean-up weeks. We have limited services and this helps residents to clean up unwanted items. Capasso, C. states that our new recreation director would like to expand programs. Duane Wright, Deputy Highway Superintendent states the cost of fuel and asphalt has gone up approx. 15% and we are trying to keep up with 9 miles of road improvements. Johnson, C. states not going over the cap, may limit the road improvements. At 7:33 PM a Special Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Pemrick with the following members present: Daniel Pemrick, Supervisor; Daniel Cochran, MaryAnn Johnson and Rick Capasso, Councilmen. Also present were Highway Superintendent Walter Barss and Dept. Highway Supt., Duane Wright. Absent was Walter E. Chandler, Councilman. There were no residents. Supervisor Pemrick states that we held a Public Hearing regarding the possibility of a Tax Cap Override.
