What level skier or snowboarder are you? --

One of the first questions someone will ask you when taking a lesson is "what level skier or rider are you?" Knowing your ability level will help us to better serve you and put you in the appropriate level class. To help you determine your ability level and get an idea of some of the possible things you'll work on during your lesson, read below.

Ski

First Time



1. Level 1 - Have never skied before. Welcome to skiing! We're going to help you build a foundation of good balance and begin to slide, glide and turn.

Novice Zone



Level 2 - Have skied once before and can glide in a wedge. May have some difficulties turning and controlling speed. May or may not have ridden a lift. We'll help you to turn and control your speed.

Level 3 - Can make wedge turns in both directions. Have ridden a lift. We'll help you vary your turn shapes and sizes, and explore more beginner terrain and some easy blue terrain.

Snowboard

First Time



Level 1 – Have never-ever snowboarded before. Welcome to riding! We're going to help you build a foundation of good balance and begin to slide, glide and turn.

Novice Zone



Level 2 - Have ridden once before. You can traverse the slope. You can also skid on toe-side and heel-side, and make J-Turns. May have some difficulties turning and controlling speed. May or may not have ridden a lift. We'll help you turn and control your speed.

Level 3 – You can link turns, stop on demand, and do ground spins. Have ridden a lift. We'll help you vary your turn shapes and sizes to conquer Green terrain and explore Blue terrain.

PASS INFORMATION

1. One registration form may be submitted for each family. All information is required and incomplete forms will be rejected.
2. All purchases final. NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO: SICKNESS, INJURY, HEALTH PROBLEMS, WEATHER CONDITIONS, NATURAL OR MAN MADE DISASTERS.
3. Age as of date of application determines eligibility. Proof of age required.
4. We will use your existing file photo if we have one. Otherwise you may come to Gore any day prior to 12/25/21 between 9am and 3pm to have your photo taken. You can pick up your Passes at the Snow Sports Desk in the Northwoods Lodge on the first day of your program. Gore Mountain reserves the right to reject online file photos.
5. An RFID pass will be issued to each participant. This identification pass, property of Gore Mountain, serves as a permanent lift ticket for all scheduled days of the program. This pass must be clearly presented to the Ticket Checker/Scanners on every lift boarding occasion.
6. If the identification pass is lost or stolen you must notify Gore Mountain at once. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged to process a new pass. A one-day ticket will be issued ONLY one time during the season for a lost or forgotten pass. A fee of \$5 per day/ticket will be charged for subsequent forgetfulness for forgotten passes only.
7. Passes are non-transferable, are for the applicant's exclusive use and may be revoked if used by someone else.
8. Ski area regulations are enforced by the reckless skier policy and New York State Code Rule 54, Article 18, "Safety In Skiing Code." Any misuse, fraudulent use, misconduct or nuisance caused by the pass holder or failure to follow New York State law or ski area policy may result in recall of the pass without refund or other consideration. Gore Mountain management reserves the right to recall passes depending upon the severity of rules infractions.
9. A parent or legal guardian of persons under age 18 must complete and sign the registration on reverse side. An email will be sent to parent with link for parent's E-signature for the Pass Terms & Conditions and Assumption of Risk Agreement.
10. All dates, rates and provisions are subject to change without notice.
11. For the entire term of this pass, I relinquish my right to a refund of the purchase price of the pass purchased that is allowable under the Safety in Skiing Code for those persons unwilling to ski because of the risks of the sport or the duties imposed upon skiers by law.
12. By purchasing this pass, the holder understands and agrees that Gore Mountain may use photographs of the holder for marketing purposes without further release. Any persons wishing not to allow Gore Mountain use of their image must complete a Pass Holder Photo Opt Out form available at the Guest Services Desk, by mail or by email upon request.
13. I have sought out, read, and agree as a pass holder to adhere to the entirety of Gore Mountain's Skier's Responsibility Code which includes, but is not limited to, an agreement to show respect for others [both off and on the slopes] and to keep off closed trails and closed areas.

Greenfield Center Recreation Ski & Snowboard Program

Please join us this winter for a 6-week Sunday ski & snowboard program for Recreation Program of Greenfield Center, for ages 7-18.

Sundays, January 9 – February 27, 2022*

* No program Jan 16 nor February 20, 2020

NEW this year - While the 6-week ski/ride program is available for ages 7-18, all levels of skiers and snowboarders, the LESSONS are only available for levels 1-3, (1st time – Novice), this season. Lessons start at 1:30. All those taking lessons can ski/ride all day prior to their lesson at 1:30. For those levels 4+, they can join the program and have an all-day lift ticket to free ski/ride each Sunday for the 6 wk program – they just would not be able to take the program lessons. See the included lesson ability level descriptions.

Program rates:

Sunday Program

Lift and lesson	\$259
Lift, lesson, rental	\$367
Pass holder rate (lessons only)*	\$187
Lift tickets only for 6 wks (no lessons)	\$140

Lesson Time

Lessons meet at 1:15, and head out on the hill at 1:30 till 3:00. Students will be grouped by age and the ability levels 1-3 ski/sb. Chaperones are required to meet children when the lessons are over. Lessons meet and are then picked up in front of the Northwoods Lodge at 3:00. Lift tickets are valid all day, and those taking lessons are welcome to come and ski/ride prior to lessons.
