February 4, 2021 Town Board Meeting

A regular meeting of the Town Board was opened by Deputy Supervisor Veitch at 7PM Thursday February 4th, 2021 at the Town Hall. Present were Supervisor Daniel Pemrick via Facetime, Deputy Supervisor Kevin Veitch; MaryAnn Johnson, Rick Capasso and Ty Stacey Councilpersons. Also present were Superintendent of Highways Justin Burwell and one resident.

Deputy Supervisor Veitch states the purpose of the meeting is to enter into an agreement with the new operators of the restaurant at Brookhaven. They need this to move ahead with the liquor license. Also to hire a Bookkeeper Trainee as Joan Stunzi will be retiring in June and to accept the Court Audit as there is a timeline when that has to be turned in.

Johnson, C states we have a License and Management agreement to grant Rich and Jody Holdings, LLC, a license to operate food, beverage and retail services for "The View at Brookhaven" at Brookhaven Golf Course. The contract is the same as we have had in years past, however, now the owners will share in part of the cost for cable and electricity during golf season. Instead of the golf membership we have given previous operators, they would like that amount in Gift Certificates they could give out and bring up people that would not necessarily come to Brookhaven. Capasso, C asks if he will be open all year? Johnson, C states they would like to see how Golf season goes, but they are interested especially with the winter sports we have there now.
