

October 20th, 2010

A Special Meeting of the Town Board was held on October 20th, 2010 at 6:45 PM with the following members present: Richard Rowland, Supervisor; Daniel Pemrick, Thomas Kinsella, Daniel Cochran and Walter E. Chandler, Councilman. Also present was Highway Supt. Walter Barss, Budget Officer/Bookkeeper Joan Kelly and 4 residents.

Joan Kelly advised that following the last workshop she adjusted the budget to include a 3 ½% salary increase for everyone as discussed, including the Board, since no decision had been made regarding their salaries. The Board has not received a raise for the past 2 years. The proposed increase to the Board would make a difference of \$1,900. Chandler, C. was opposed to a raise. The Board is taking money out of reserves for this budget and did not feel that the Board should have a raise. Cochran, C. stated that originally he was not in favor of a raise either. Since the Board has not had a raise in 2 years, he would not be opposed to the 2% raise that was originally proposed. Kinsella, C. agreed with a 2% increase.

FURTHER NOTICE is hereby given that the Town Board of the Town of Greenfield will meet and review said preliminary budget and hold a public hearing thereon, at the Town Hall, Greenfield Center, NY at 7:25 PM on the 4th day of November, 2010, and that at that hearing any person may be heard in favor of or against the preliminary budget as compiled, or for or against any item or items as therein contained.

Pursuant to Section 113 of the Town Law, the proposed salaries of the following Town officers are hereby specified as follows: Supervisor - \$18,575.;
